

Uffington School

On Monday 23rd May, SPS went to Uffington School and the children showed us around. The head teacher is called Mrs Carnell.

The children showed us years 6 and 5 in Class 3, years 4 and 3 in Class 2, years 2 and 1 in Class 1 and foundation and preschool in the nursery unit. There are 105 children in the school, with classes having between 20 and 30 children.

There are 4 teacher roles, filled by 6 teachers, 2 preschool staff and 5 teaching assistants.

Like us they have Christian Values but theirs are Respect, Trust and Perseverance. Uffington School have houses called Betjeman, Saunders and Hughes rather than merits like us. They are awarded for hard work, excellent behaviour and appropriate attitudes.

They have a lovely outside area with a trim trail and storytelling area.

We had a lovely visit and some yummy biscuits and drink!
