Overleaf is a brief note prepared by each candidate about themselves.

When you have chosen your preferred candidates, please:

1. Fold the ballot paper - **do not write your name on the ballot paper.**
2. Place your folded ballot paper in the envelope provided and **write your name on the envelope so that it can be checked against the list of eligible voters.** (The envelope will be opened and discarded by the independent scrutineer without looking at the vote cast.)
3. If envelopes are returned without a name on the envelope all candidates will be asked if they wish to accept them. If all candidates agree to accept unnamed envelopes; the result goes ahead. If one candidate disagrees all unnamed envelopes are disregarded.
4. Deliver your ballot to the school (in person) and place in the ballot box which will be available between **Monday 8th October** and **Thursday 18th October** in the school foyer.

All ballot papers must be received by Thursday 18th October at 5.30pm. Ballot papers received after this date, for whatever reason, will not be counted.
