On Tuesday 21st May Year 6 went to the fire station in Oxford to take part in Junior Citizen.

During their two hour visit all the children experienced different safety scenarios and each child was given the opportunity to practice making a 999 telephone call. All the sessions were interactive, where children were taught a variety of life skills which focused upon how to keep themselves safe whilst potentially helping others who may be in difficulty or distress.

Based on the controlled learning experiences provided, children were encouraged to make decisions which they may face during a real life emergency.

It was a brilliant afternoon and the children made some sensible decisions / suggestions.
