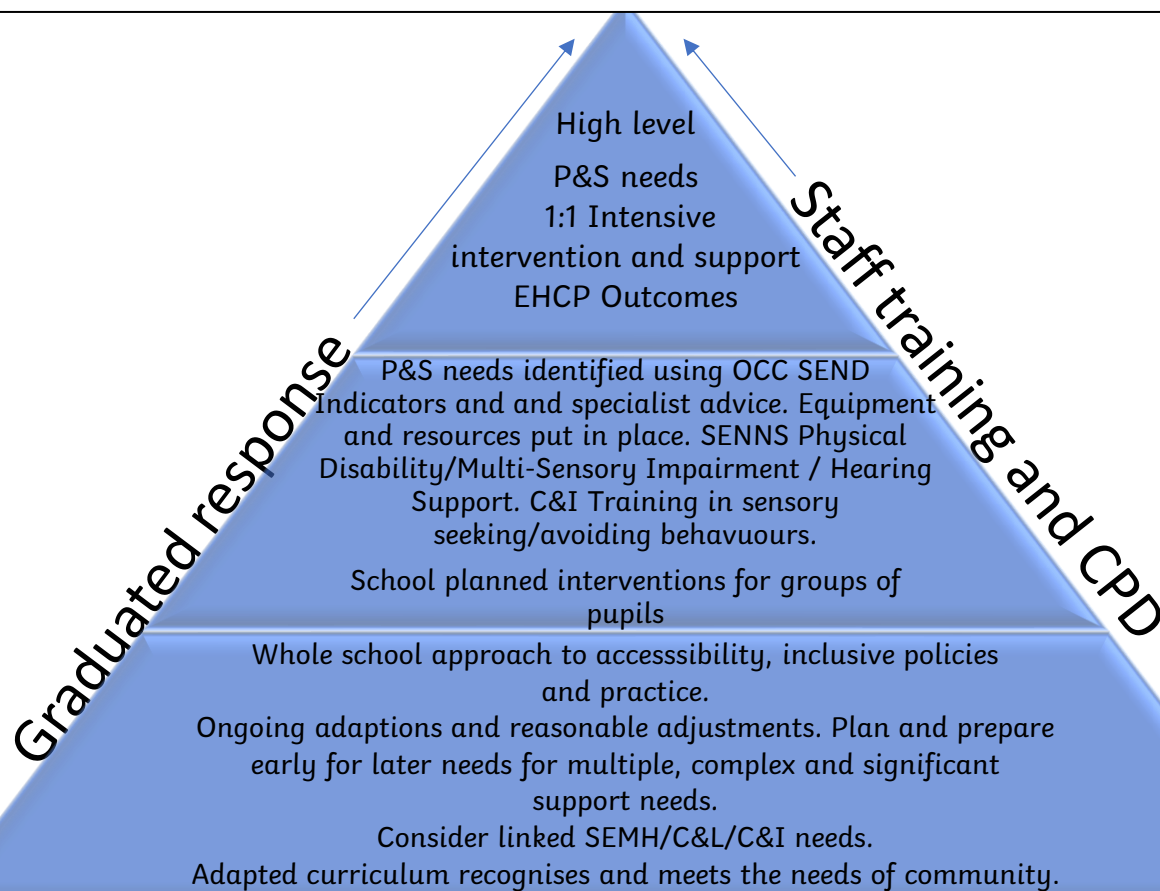

- Sensory profiles, sensory diet
- Sensory room, no shoes, sensory circuits, bucket time, weighted blankets, bean bags
- Occupational Therapy advice.
- Handwriting programmes, motor control activities, equipment -pencil grips, adapted scissors etc
- Bubble machine, sensory toys/games

- Ensure classrooms and school areas are calm and organised.
- Safe spaces / calm areas.
- Ensure equipment is easily accessible.
- Ensure furniture is arranged to accommodate free movement.
- TGMC movement breaks, calm classroom displays/hessian backing, noise level monitors, noise cancelling headphones, alternative seating
- Walks, fidget toys, chewy, multisensory resources.
- Thoughtful seating, away from noise, light, over-stimulation
